

Ca' Fedespina, Toscana Igt 2018
Top 100 Italian Wines

The pure Merlot of Podere Fedespina is the Bordeaux counterpart of Pinot Noir, Burgundy in Lunigiana.

The 2018 harvest shines from the nose with its own light, broad and open on the blackberry and cherry. Palate in the wake, on a perfect taste-olfactory correspondence.

A savory character accompanies the sip from entry to finish, making it irresistible to drink a wine that does nothing to hide (and why should it, on the other hand?) its entire structure.

Very young wine, with **great perspective**. which shines in persistence, on delicious returns of **crunchy fruit**.

Vermentino, Durella and Chardonnay:

a white that tells the story of **Lunigiana**, a land to discover in which the "**Winery of the Year**" of the **2022** edition of our Wine Guide operates. Full, bright straw yellow. Splendid on the nose, with hints of citrus fruits, fresh white and yellow flowers.

Further in the background, essences of the **Mediterranean scrub** such as laurel and rosemary. Great **citrus tension**, hints of green apple, light tannic and - even more - savory perception, forming the backbone of the nectar on the palate.

The result is a wine that combines, like few others, great **drinkability** and a high gastronomic profile.





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Pinot Noir from vines over **50 years old**. At sight it has a typical bright ruby red.

Nose on berries, strawberry in full view. Savory character, great **freshness**, citrus on the currants and cassis.

A vintage that shines in **persistence**, with delicious returns of crunchy fruit.
